

## Call for posters

We cordially invite you to present your innovative advisory tools and methods, education and advisory projects and offers or relevant research results in the form of a poster. These should have relevance for rural extension and education and be assignable to one of the following categories:

- **Advisory work in the context of rapidly changing framework conditions**
- **Innovation and Resilience in Education and Advisory Work**
- **Networking and new Learning Culture in the agricultural knowledge system AKIS**

### Technical requirements

The poster (in .jpg or .png format) should be designed in such a way that it can be displayed legibly in landscape format on a 24-inch screen (60.92 cm) with 1920 x 1080 pixels without scrolling.

It should also contain

- title, author and contact information
- be visually appealing and not overloaded with information
- Language: Preferably in English or bilingual.

In addition to the poster, we ask you to create a short film (in mp4 format) with a maximum length of 1 minute in which you explain in English (and in German if you speak German) why it is worth looking at your poster.

### Poster presentation

The poster session will take place on Thursday, 10 June from 1:00-2:15 pm. The best posters will be awarded on 11 June at 11:15 by on-line voting by the participants. Please note that a contact person must be available during the poster session to present your poster and to answer questions if necessary. This will be done by connecting the person in [wonder.me](https://wonder.me). A technical test for this will be carried out in good time before the conference.
